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# Our Story

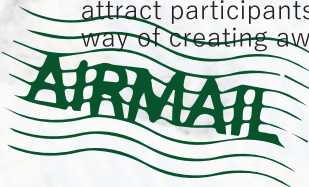


The Moses Kotane area is strategically located in terms of important provincial tourism routes and is ideally positioned to benefit from provincial tourism activities and initiatives. The area is directly influenced by two of the primary provincial tourism nodes in the NW Province i.e. the Sun City complex and the Pilanesberg National Park. The Sun City Resort is situated adjacent to Pilanesberg National Park and consists of several Hotels, an artificial beach with a water adventure park, several conference centres, adult entertainment centers and a golf courses. Sun City has evolved from a resort targeting the domestic gaming market to an integrated resort servicing a high number of high yield markets.

Several high profile events are regularly hosted at Sun City and include events such as the Nedbank Million Dollar Golf Challenge and regular performances of several international celebrities have performed at the Sun City Superbowl. The artificial beach and water adventure park is a main attraction in various tourist events such as beach parties, the hosting of beauty pageants and surfing competitions. Sun City attracts more than a million visitors and Pilanesberg National Park more than 350,000 visitors a year.

The Pilanesberg Nature Reserve and the Sun City / Lost City Resort are the main tourist attraction centres in Moses Kotane. Apart from these, there are a number of smaller isolated nature reserves like the Madikwe, Impala, Kwa Maritane, Manyane and Bakgatla Game Reserves. These nature reserves are actively utilized through activities such as game lodges, walking trails, holiday resorts, game hunting, etc. Other tourism facilities comprise of the Molatedi Dam, Madikwe Dam, the Roodeval Farm where there are rock paintings, and the Kolotwane River Valley near Silwerkraans.

Furthermore, the proposed Pilanesberg / Madikwe Corridor (Heritage Park) represents a major new tourism initiative within Moses Kotane. This initiative has the potential to act as a catalyst for greater economic investment in the municipality. As part of awareness creation of this project, Heritage Park Walk event is organised annually. The walk usually starts from Pilanesberg National Park and end at Madikwe Game Reserve. This annual event takes place during the first week of June, as per practice, and includes World Environment Day. The event also seeks to attract participants from all-over the country to take part in the event as a way of creating awareness beyond the affected communities.

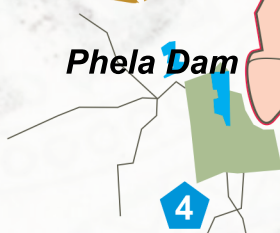
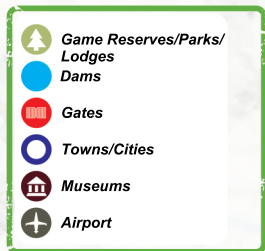

# About Moses Mauane Kotane



Moses Mauane Kotane (9 August 1905 – 19 May 1978) was a South African politician and activist. Kotane was secretary general of the South African Communist Party from 1939 until his death in 1978.

In 1928, Kotane joined the African National Congress but left it, considering it weak and ineffectual. Later that year he joined the African Bakers Union, an affiliate of the new Federation of Non-European Trade Unions then being built by SACP. Kotane joined SACP a year later in 1929, soon becoming a member of the party's politburo. In 1931, he became a full-time functionary of SACP. Within the Communist Party, Kotane worked on Umsebenzi, the party's newspaper. As a promising young party member, Kotane was sent to Moscow to study Marxism-Leninism at the International Lenin School. In Moscow, Kotane studied under Andre Sik, 1967 recipient of the Lenin Peace Prize and other Marxist theorists. Returning to South Africa in 1933, Kotane advanced through the Party until the point where he became the party's general secretary in 1939.

## Political Legacy

Kotane was a well-respected member of the struggle for majority rule in South Africa by even non-communist leaders. Walter Sisulu credited him as a "giant of the struggle" because of his logical and non-dogmatic approach. Kotane was also a leading member of the African National Congress at the same time as the SACP. With the African National Congress, Kotane served as Treasurer General from 1963 to 1973 when he was replaced by Thomas Nkobi. Kotane, representing the Communist Party, attended the 1955 Asian-African Conference in Bandung, Indonesia. From 1956 to 1961, Kotane was a defendant in the Treason Trial alongside fellow South African leaders Nelson Mandela, Joe Modise, Albert Luthuli, Joe Slovo, Walter Sisulu and 151 others. Despite years of prosecution, none of the defendants, including Kotane, were convicted.

## Later Life

Kotane suffered a stroke in 1968. Following the stroke, he went for treatment in the Soviet Union, where he died on 19 May 1978. On the 1 March 2015, Moses Kotane's remains were returned to South Africa and he will be reburied on 14 March at Pella, North West.

Kotane was honoured with the Isitwalandwe Medal by the ANC in 1975. A local municipality is named after him in North West Province, South Africa.

## **How to get here**

From Pretoria or Johannesburg, it's about 350 km, or a four-hour journey on good roads. Depending on the lodge you are staying in, the directions might be quite different, so inquire first. Or you could inquire from your lodge of choice about air charters. There is also a local airport near Sun City.

## **Length of stay**

A week will provide sufficient time to experience the many attractions.

## **Best time to visit**

Any time of year. Summers are very hot. Consider going between March and November, when temperatures are lower.

You have a choice of more than 20 game lodges - all of them with varying degrees of luxury and comfort. There is also a myriad of accommodation for outdoor lovers including backpackers, camp sites, and guest houses.

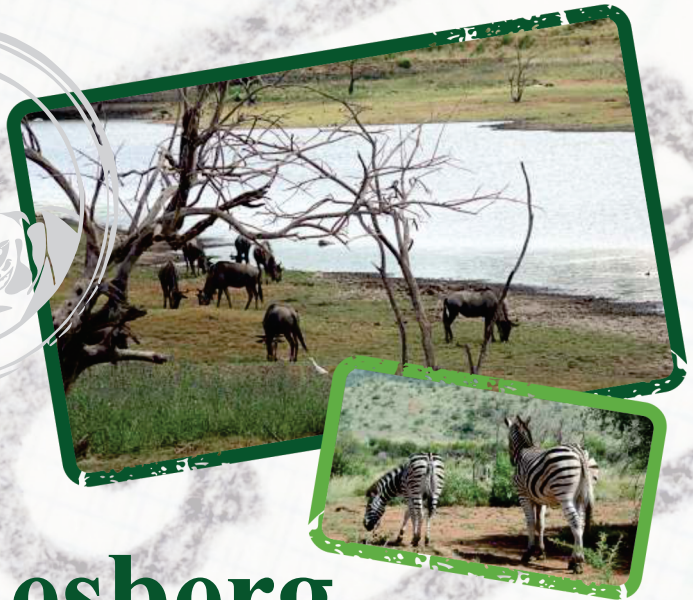

# The First School of Bakgatla-Ba-Kgafela

This wall marks the site where Kgosi Kgamanyane was flogged by the Boers for refusing to provide free labour. Soon after the flogging he gathered his people and moved to Mochudi, Botswana.

# Letlapa La Pula



This is a rock where the King would come to pray for rain. The king was the only person legible for rainmaking. The art of rainmaking was traditionally the responsibility of the kgosi. This rock marks the site where Kgosi Ramono practiced the rainmaking. Rainmaking rites were solely for the king.

Sebilo Heritage Casting is a cultural empowerment private company that teaches the historical background of Batswana and enlighten tourists with history of Bakgatla ba Kgafela Tribe in the Pilanesburg area and other South African Tribes. 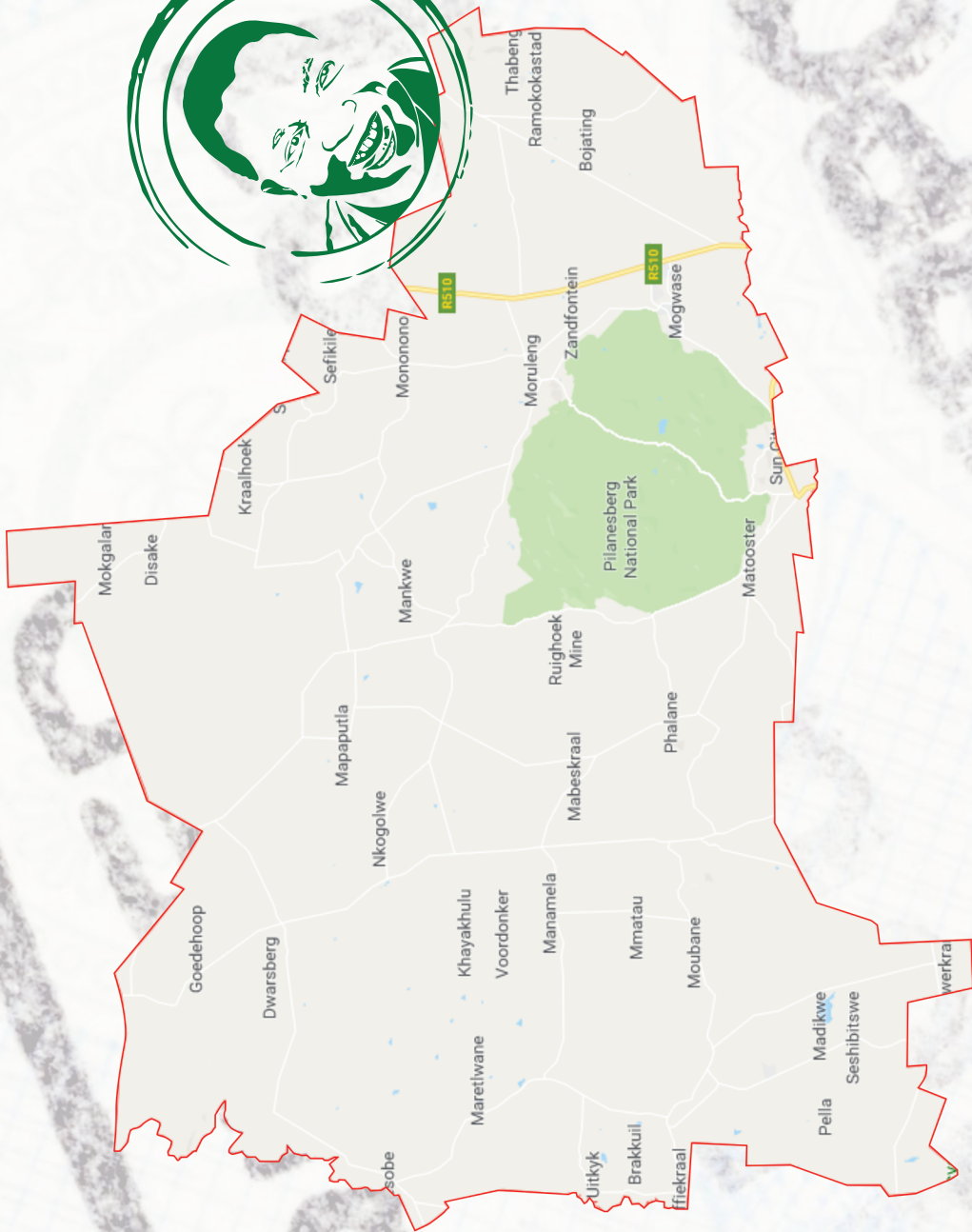
