PUBLIC ALERT FAKE MUNICIPAL JOBS/ SCAM

Moses kotane Local Municipality would like to inform members of the public about fake municipal jobs circulating currently on social media.

The first message it was as follow" ***plumbing jobs with requirement stated there as Drivers licence. Municipality is looking for 8 people***".

Secondly, today, the other fraudster is ***calling people promising them fake municipal jobs with a bribe worth R2 000, demanding a deposit of atleast R1 000 so as to be hired.***

The Moses Kotane Local Municipality would like to make an appeal to the public to note that those messages are Fake Municipal jobs or Scams. Communities are formally cautioned so that they must not fall for those Cash scams.

Community members must ignore such messages, as it was a scam looking to con vulnerable community members who are desperate for jobs.

The community must further note that Jobs are not for sale at Moses Kotane Local Municipality and at no stage should a person pay any amount for whatever reason in order to secure a job at the municipality.

The Municipality has approved Human Resource Management policies and procedures which allows all approved vacancies to be advertised on the National Newspapers for all interested candidates to apply, which does not include anyone to pay upfront.

The Municipality urge everyone with information to report those perpetrators to the law enforcement agencies.
