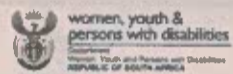
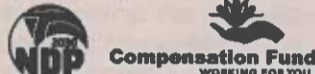

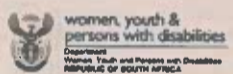

Makhubedu upbeat about club's future despite defeat

Sekhukhune victims of unlucky penalty call

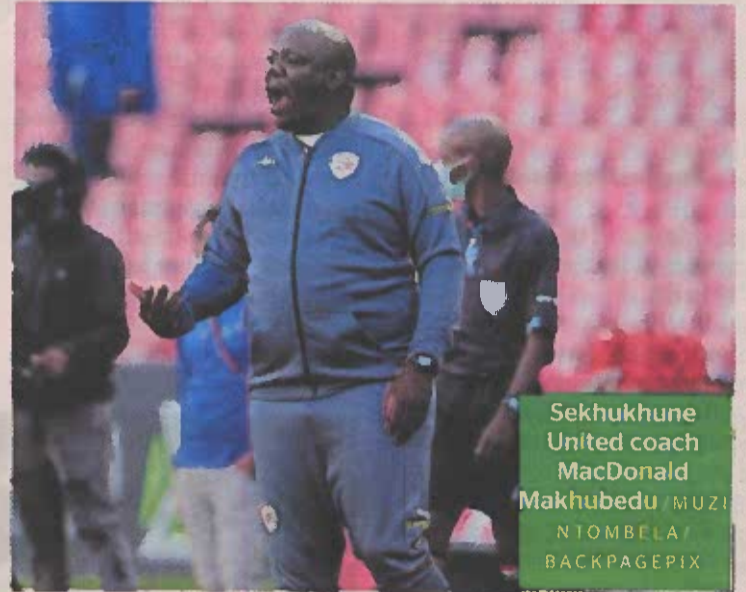
Despite losing to champions Mamelodi Sundowns in the DStv Premiership encounter at the Tuks Stadium at the weekend, Sekhukhune United coach MacDonald Makhubedu believes they will give many teams a tough time in the league this season.

Makhubedu praised his team for their character, and he is of the view that they are on the right track in their debut season in the Premiership.

A first-half goal by Neo Maela and a second-half penalty by Themba Zwane helped the Brazilians to a 2-0 victory against the rookies.

Despite the loss, they are in a good position in third place on the log with 20 points from 12 matches. Makhubedu is confident of a top-eight finish.

United wanted to be strong defensively and play on the

counter-attack but it backfired when they conceded inside the opening 20 minutes.

Peter Shalulile's shot appeared to hit Nyiko Mobbie on the chest but the referee awarded Sundowns a penalty in the 59th minute.

However, the modest Makhubedu said to err was human, and he forgave the ref-

eree for the costly error that increased the advantage for the home side.

"We are targeting about 27 points in the first round. We will be safe if we can get 10 more points in the second round. We are on the right track, and we want to be in the top 10 and top eight at the end of the season."
